**Important Notice for Travelers**

India has implemented Yellow Fever vaccine entry requirements under the International Health Regulations (IHR) 2005.

Under IHR, travelers > 9 months of age, arriving from Ghana - Yellow Fever Endemic Country (as notified by GoI from time to time, available at <https://www.ihpoe.mohfw.gov.in/vaccination.php>) may take note of the following:

All travelers departing for India must possess a valid Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate (YFVC) issued by an authorized Yellow Fever vaccination center upon arrival.

The certificate becomes valid 10 days after vaccination; therefore, travelers must be vaccinated at least 10 days before their departure to India. Travelers without possession of a valid certificate or with an immature certificate are quarantined for a maximum period of 6 days at designated facilities as per IHR. Also, there is no diplomatic immunity to these guidelines.
